- 2.** All instructions of the Minister, or persons acting on his/her behalf are complied with.
- 3.** The applicant shall make good, or pay the cost of making good, any damage to property arising out of the use of this permit.
- 4.** No structure, or installation may be constructed or installed without the written permission of Glenveagh Mountains National Park.
- 5.** This permit does not give exclusive use of the site (*Glenveagh National Park is used by other groups, licensees and right-holders*).
- 6.** The permit holder will ensure that all of their agents and assigns are informed that they are in a National Park and must ensure that they do not leave litter. (*Litter includes biodegradable waste*).
- 7.** The permit holder will inform Glenveagh National Park upon both activation and termination of permitted activities.
- 8.** The DCO at Glenveagh National Park is contacted at 087 6672213 in the case of any notable incidents occurring throughout the period of this permission, e.g. accidents, etc.
- 9.** Glenveagh National Park is acknowledged in any public communication resulting from your activities in the National Park.
- 10.** Any additional special conditions set by Glenveagh National Park as required (assessed on a case-by-case basis).
